

a 95% cure rate when detected early. As part of the awareness initiative, mammograms, typically costing over Rs 3,750, are being offered at a concessional rate of Rs 1,000 this month."

Minimally invasive heart surgery for faster recovery of patients and better outcomes

After the pandemic, our lives have taken a tectonic shift. Increasing screen time, consumption of junk food, corona infection, vaccinations and thrombosis in few, have together caused a substantial rise in heart diseases. If you live in a locality where a carbon-emitting factory is operational, it might add to the risk.

Our recommendation is to opt for early detection and preventive therapy, with a master health check up from the age of 40. If you have a family history of heart problems, or if you are a smoker, diabetic or overweight, do this earlier. In diabetic patients, we have found all their blood vessels are destroyed at an earlier age. Silent Myocardial infarction is common among

diabetes patients. The only way their heart can be taken care of is by keeping a control on diabetes 24 X 7 and a regular check up with a Diabetologist.

What happens after I meet a cardiologist for chest pain?

You may be asked to undergo

a Coronary angiogram. It is a test to check the blood vessels supplying your heart and is very accurate in detecting lesions and gives the doctor a clear idea on what treatment will be required for you.

Minimal Invasive Cardiac Surgery

Heart diseases after being detected will need correction and the conventional way of treating them (heart diseases due to blockages in the blood supply or valve damage) is by doing an open-heart surgery. Open heart surgery is done for bypassing blockages in the heart by cutting open the breast bone. After the surgery is done the surgeon uses steel wires to bind the bones edges together and the healing processes for the bone to heal take around 2 to 3 months.

In Minimally invasive cardiac surgery (MICS) the same surgery is done through a small 5 cms hole, made on the side of the chest. Bypass surgery and valve replacement surgeries can be performed without cutting through any bone. Since there is no cutting of bones the

recovery period is very quick and the pain endured by the patient is also minimal. Within few days they are up and ready to do their routine activities, and this is the greatest advantage of MICS.

Break through Surgeries performed by the MICS method

At KG Hospital, we started the minimal invasive programme in 2017. The first case was a mitral valve replacement. This procedure is done through the right side of the chest. We put a small 4 to 5 cm incision over the chest, the heart was stopped, the damaged valve was removed and replaced with a prosthetic valve. After the procedure, the patient stayed in the hospital for 5 days. He got back to his routine in a week's time. The pain score recorded post

procedure was 2/10 throughout the recovery period.

In Jan 2017 we started doing AVR's and CABG's through Minimally invasive approach.

We did five bypasses for patient with multiple blocks as early as June 2018. It is important, all blood vessels are grafted

to achieve complete revascularization and it translates to good long term results to patients.

In February 2022, we did the 1st Trans-axillary Aortic valve replacement, probably the first time in India. It opened a way of treatment for the patients undergoing Aortic valve surgeries. The incision



squeezing their chest or a heavy weight lying on their chest. Angina may be a new pain that needs to be checked by a doctor, or recurring pain that goes away with treatment. Although angina is relatively common, it can still be hard to distinguish from other




